## HISTORY

The Crowley House of Hope began seventeen years ago – opening its doors April 17, 1994 at its first facility on South Texas Street – in response to the growing need for an assistance program in the Crowley ISD area. Within a few months of opening its doors, Crowley House of Hope had outgrown that tiny first facility, and moved to its second location on Main St in August of 1994. On October 1, 2001 we moved into a new 5,000 sq. foot building located at 216 N. Magnolia.

A Thrift Shop was opened to better utilize our many donations, to be of service to the community and to raise money for financial assistance. It is operated entirely by wonderful and faithful volunteers. The Thrift Shop hours are 9 am to 4 pm Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

In 2004 a new 3,000 sq. foot building was opened for needed expansion and today houses the clinic.

In 2006 a third building was built. The 4000 sq. ft. building will allow needed space for our special projects and needed storage. The new building is utilized to distribute items for the “Share the Love Holiday House” program.

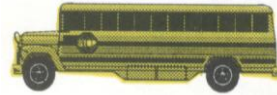

### “BACK TO SCHOOL”



The “Back to School” program provides school supplies for children in our service area, which covers 70 square miles. There are many children whose families need help just providing for basics. Having new school supplies at the beginning of school helps the children’s self-esteem and makes beginning school a joy instead of an embarrassment. The Crowley House of Hope provided school supplies and uniforms for over 750 children for the 2010-2011 school year at a cost of over \$15,000.

### “THANKSGIVING BASKETS”



In 2010 Thanksgiving baskets were provided to 275 families. Each basket contained the making of a complete Thanksgiving dinner including the turkey provided by Albertson’s and First Presbyterian Church of Crowley. Many area mission-minded churches provided the ingredients for all these baskets.

## “SHARE THE LOVE HOLIDAY HOUSE”



“Share the Love,” our Christmas program provides toys, clothing and a generous portion of food for children whose families qualify residentially and for financial assistance. In 2010, 300 families with 875 children enjoyed a happy holiday thanks to the Share the Love and Holiday House, Christmas program. There was a tremendous selection of toys, games, electronics, clothing and stocking stuffers for families to choose from. The community was greatly involved underwriting the expense of over \$26,000, plus the numerous in-kind-gifts and coming out in force to volunteer to help. Over 200 community volunteers assisted the families as they selected toys and clothing, wrapped gifts, and distributed over 980 sacks of food to the families. We are grateful to the caring community of Crowley. We feel that when a need is known, there is an immediate response. Thanks to everyone who donated funds, toys, clothing, food, and time to help make this Christmas a happy time for so many people.

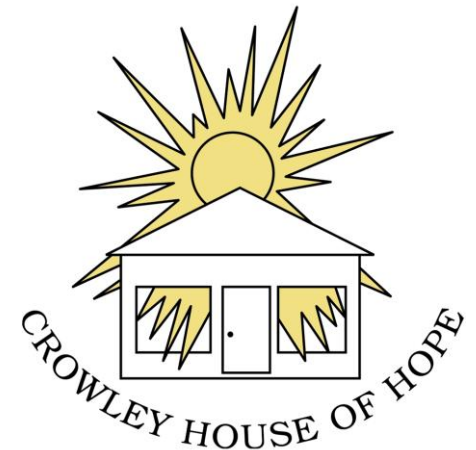
